



National Youth Festival is an Occasion that Indicates the Future of the Country: NUEYS Chairman

In an interview he conducted with ERINA, the Chairman of the NUEYS, Mr. Sultan Sied, said that the National Youth Festival is a special event which brings Eritrean youths from both inside the country and abroad together while at the same time highlighting ongoing development endeavours as well as indicating where the country is headed.
